Each week, you will be responsible for (1) activity on the back on this sheet. When you complete the activity, you will submit digital evidence via Google Classroom that the activity was completed (screenshot, video, summary, etc.). After 5 are submitted, you will then submit ONE reflection on week 6.

- 1. Evidence that the activity was performed (video, photo of activity being completed, printout of results, etc.). This semester, these will be submitted ONLY through Google Classroom. If you do have to turn in a hard copy of something into the tray (like a product you have created), this should be noted on the document provided in Google Classroom. To earn your full 60 Pts (12 each submission), your evidence should demonstrate the activity was actually carried out.
- 2. A Reflection Minimum of 500 words in English. Submitted once after all 5 T/S have been completed. During your reflection, think about how the activities compare to one another and how they each hit our 5 ACTFL Standards:
- Communities Getting engaged with the language beyond the classroom in a real life setting.
- Culture How is the culture represented through the activities?
- **Connections** What connections can you make between things we have discussed in class to the culture?
- Comparisons How do the activities compare with American culture?
- **Communication** How is the language being represented in the activity? Are you hearing the language? Speaking it? Etc.

Grading: This Quarter you will get 1 grade for T/S. This will count 15% of your class grade.
